Arenas of Conflict

[Ephesians 6:10-13](#)

We welcome you to this weekend of worship at Concord. God has certainly seized our attention in these early days of 2021. He reminds us that "The Battle Belongs to the Lord" while at the same time encouraging us to stand strong. Put on the whole armor. Victory is certain, but the battle is real.

This weekend we are looking at various arenas we stand in as a Christian soldier. In preparing for this message I simply searched for occasions where Satan, the devil, or the wicked one is used in Scripture. My search was not exhaustive. I am sure I overlooked some important places, but I have categorized these occasions under four headings. These are all "Arenas of Conflict".

I. Governmental Arena ([1 Chronicles 21:1](#))

II. Congregational Arena ([Acts 5:3](#))

III. Marital Arena ([1 Corinthians 7:5](#))

IV. Personal Arena ([Acts 26:18](#))

I will be introducing you to several texts that lead us into those four arenas. In addition, I remind you that our warfare is spiritual in nature, but just as real as any physical battle.
