IN THE BEGINNING

Genesis 1

Over these next several weeks we will be digging into the opening chapters of Genesis and the closing chapters of Revelation. Revelation 1:8 sets the theme - "I am Alpha and Omega, the beginning and the ending..." I want to tie together the beginning and the end.

We start today with "In the Beginning". This is a great place to start. We should not begin at the end but at the beginning. Genesis chapter 1 is not important because of its poetic beauty. It is important because it is factual. It is true. The believer's trust in scripture makes some people uncomfortable. I am most concerned that many believers feel they must reconcile the biblical account of creation with evolutionary theory. Truthfully, they are irreconcilable.
