**Some Things Never Change**

***Genesis 8:1-4; 9:1-7, 12-13, 18-19***

Welcome to this weekend at Concord as we continue our series “The Beginning and the End.” This weekend we are considering the great changes that Noah found as he and his family exited the ark. Things had radically changed, but as we will discover, “Some Things Never Change.”

Our text today comes from various places in Genesis 8-11. In addition, Revelation 17 and 18 point to a day when the best-made plans of mankind come crashing down. God destroyed Babel in Genesis 11, and He will bring down Babylon the Great in Revelation 18. Between these texts, we discover that man continues to rebel against God’s plan.

In Genesis, He shows us what is not acceptable to God.

- II. Do not approach God with Calloused Hands.**
- III. Do not approach God with Clever Plans.**
