THE CREATION OF MAN

Genesis 1:26-27; Genesis 2

This Sunday we will dig into our second sermon in the series "The Beginning and the End". This particular series is dealing with some very important issues related to how this world started, according to the Genesis account, and how it will end, according to Revelation. We are not striving to be culturally relevant, but rather to be biblically accurate. As we stay with the Bible, we find ourselves very relevant in this present-day context.

I am preaching this week on "The Creation of Man". Our primary text is all of Genesis 2. Genesis 2 is an opening up of Genesis 1:26-27. There are three things we want to examine regarding the creation of mankind.

- I. **We were created by God's Powerful Decree.**
He spoke the word and it was so.
- II. **We were created by God's Particular Design.**
We are unlike any other created thing.
- III. **We were created for God's Personal Delight.**
We were made for His pleasure.
