If I can sit down for freedom, you can stand up for children. **Director's Corner** 

When World War 2 broke out in Europe in September 1939, 90 percent of Americans wanted the U.S. to stay out. Our posture was one of neutrality and isolation.

Meanwhile in Great Britian Neville Chamberlain thought the best plan for dealing with Hitler was to keep giving in, appeasement.

Neutrality, isolation, and appeasement—none of these tactics were successful in dealing with an unrelenting and evil adversary. Britain found the more they remained passive and gave in, the more the enemy demanded. The U.S. found this foe was not content to allow them to mind their own business, but was determined to come after them as well.

Mama and mawmaw bears, we are in a war too. Our war is not one of guns and tanks, but it's one that is even more sinister. It's a spiritual war involving the enemy of our souls. He is more wicked and more relentless than any flesh and blood despot. He is coming for the most vulnerable and precious among us, our children!

Other states in our country have succumbed to

this enemy. State after state is taking away parental rights when it comes to their minor children and decisions regarding gender reassignment procedures. We should not be so naïve to think MO is immune.

The proposed MO Constitutional change entitled Amendment 3 (A3) involves more than abortion.
